Background Information:

The School Supply Project was organized in 1986 by Resurrection Lutheran Church to provide school supplies to children of needy families. Last year new supplies were provided to 3,035 students in all grades throughout PISD. Since the beginning, over 34,000 students have received supplies. Referrals are made through the Assistance Center of Collin County.

Manuscript tablets for grades 1, 2, 3	Folders with pockets
Folders with pockets and brads	Zipper pouch for 3-ring binder
#2 pencils	Red grading pencils
Ballpoint pens - blue, black or red	Colored pencils -12 count
Watercolors, 8 count	Crayons, 24 count
Felt markers, thick or thin, washable	School glue, 4 oz
Glue sticks	Pointed school scissors, 5”
Eraser, large pink	12” plastic ruler
Highlighters– yellow preferred	Index cards, 3x5 (ruled)
